Hikes We Will Enjoy:

Borestone Mountain Audubon Sanctuary // 3.6 miles

Among Maine's most popular hiking destinations, Borestone Mountain offers a moderately strenuous climb that culminates with spectacular 360-degree views from two peaks at nearly 2,000 feet.



Gulf Hagas // 11.8 miles

Often dubbed "The Grand Canyon of Maine," Gulf Hagas features a rugged and remote trail network along a deep river gorge with many scenic waterfalls.
